



Extract from a letter from Lieutenant D.W. Child, 3rd March
1943.

[I should be very grateful if you would convey, officially, my thanks to the Netherland Government for the treatment that I received whilst I was in the Roode Kruis Ziekenhuis at the Hague. Had I been a Dutch officer I could not have had better treatment.

I should like to make special mention of the attention that I received from the surgeon, Dr. Exalto who, for the whole of the six months that I was in hospital, visited me every day; his assistant Dr. Whytoff and Zuster Smits, the Head Sister on the ground floor.]
